



# China-ASEAN International Youth Summer Camp

## Concept Note

July 22-28, 2025

Guiyang City, Guizhou Province, China

### I. Background

To further expand the impact of the International Youth Talk and provide outstanding participants with deeper, hands-on learning experiences, the China-ASEAN International Youth Summer Camp will be held from July 22 to 28 in Guiyang City, Guizhou Province, China.

The program is organized by SEAMEO TED, Guizhou Polytechnic of Construction and co-organized by Go Study Global Education. It will invite 10 to 15 outstanding young participants from 6 to 8 ASEAN countries to take part in this immersive offline exchange. These participants will be selected from among the top-performing student speakers of the International Youth Talk.

In Guiyang, they will engage in interactive activities with local Chinese students, explore the forefront of architectural technology through field visits to leading construction and design enterprises, and immerse themselves in rich cultural experiences.

One of the highlights of the camp is a curated journey through time and design — from traditional Chinese architecture to cutting-edge modern structures — allowing participants to appreciate the beauty and evolution of architectural forms in China.

The camp aims to inspire youth, strengthen China-ASEAN exchanges, and promote mutual understanding and friendship through architecture as a shared cultural language.

To inspire students' interest in the field of architecture;  
To provide a platform for hands-on learning and meaningful interaction.
