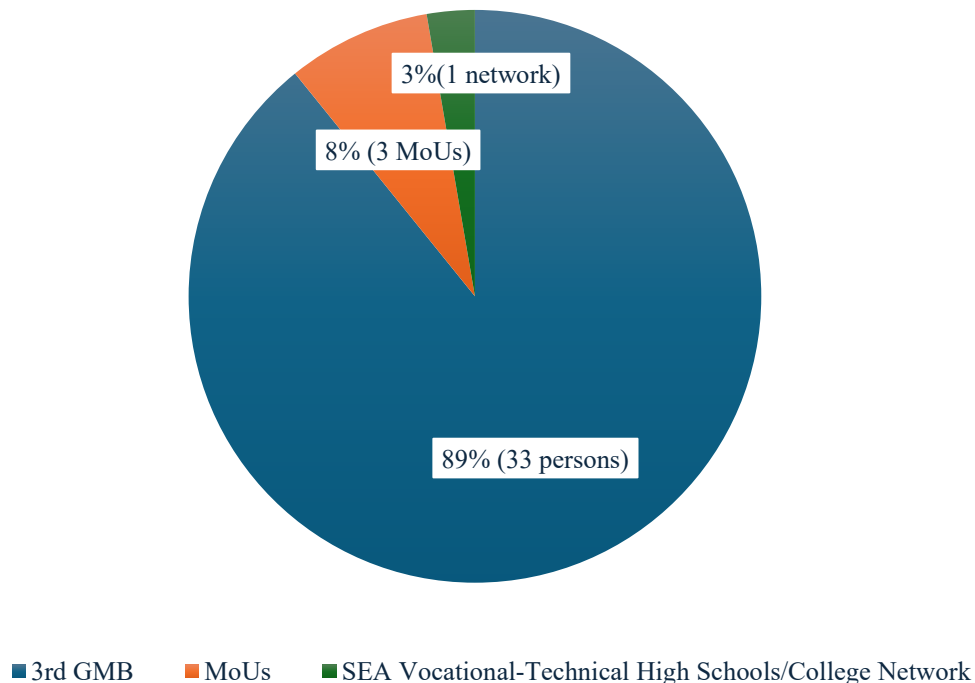
I. 2020 Achievements

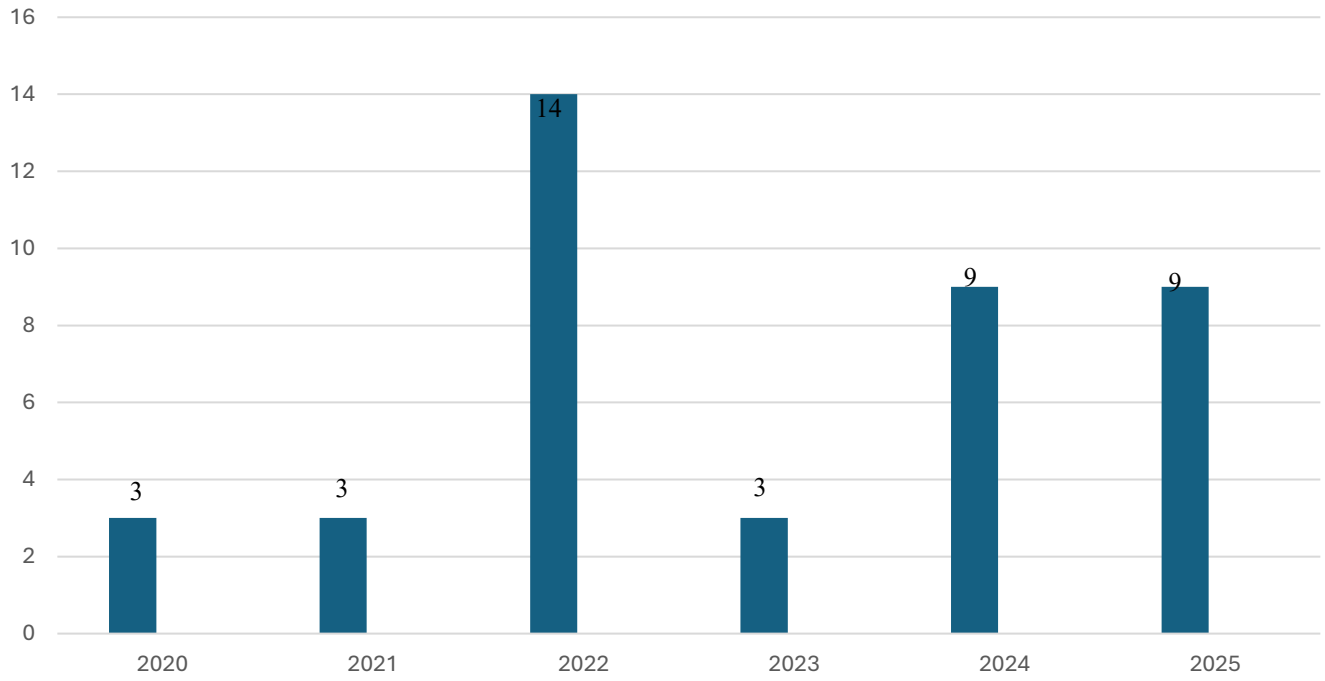

Number of Activities 2020-2025 for Public Relations and Partnership Division

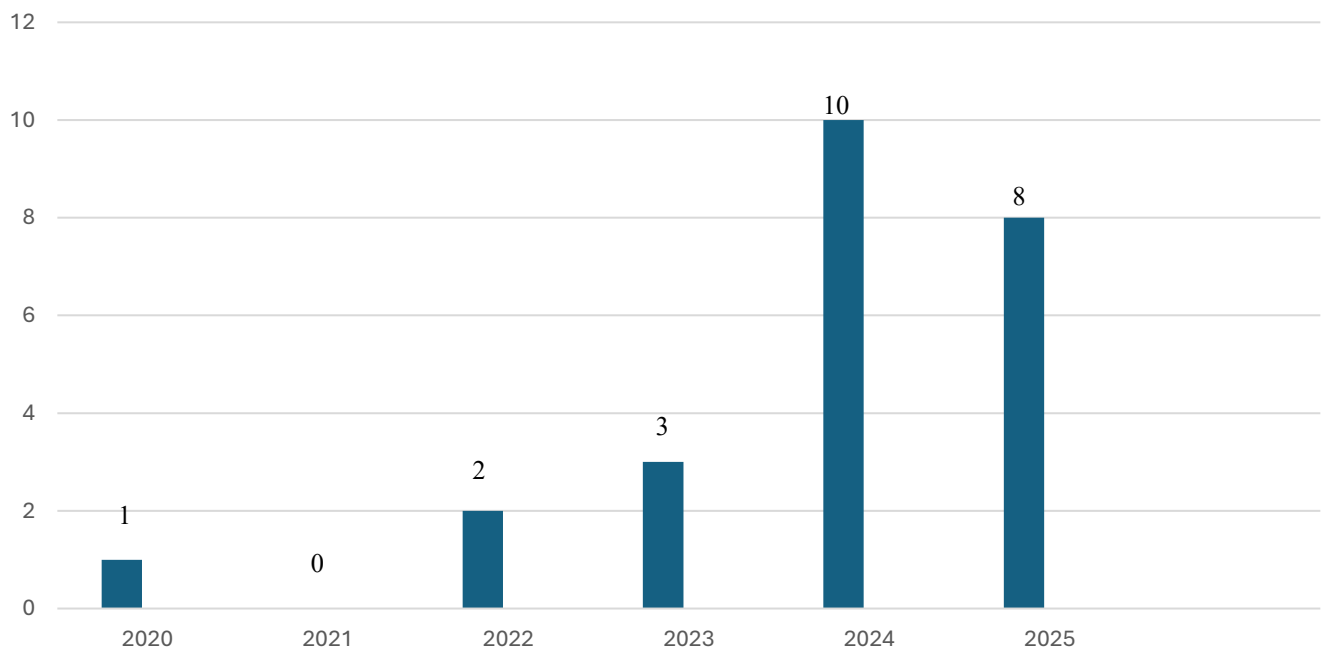


2020-2025 Number of MoUs for Public Relations and Partnership Division

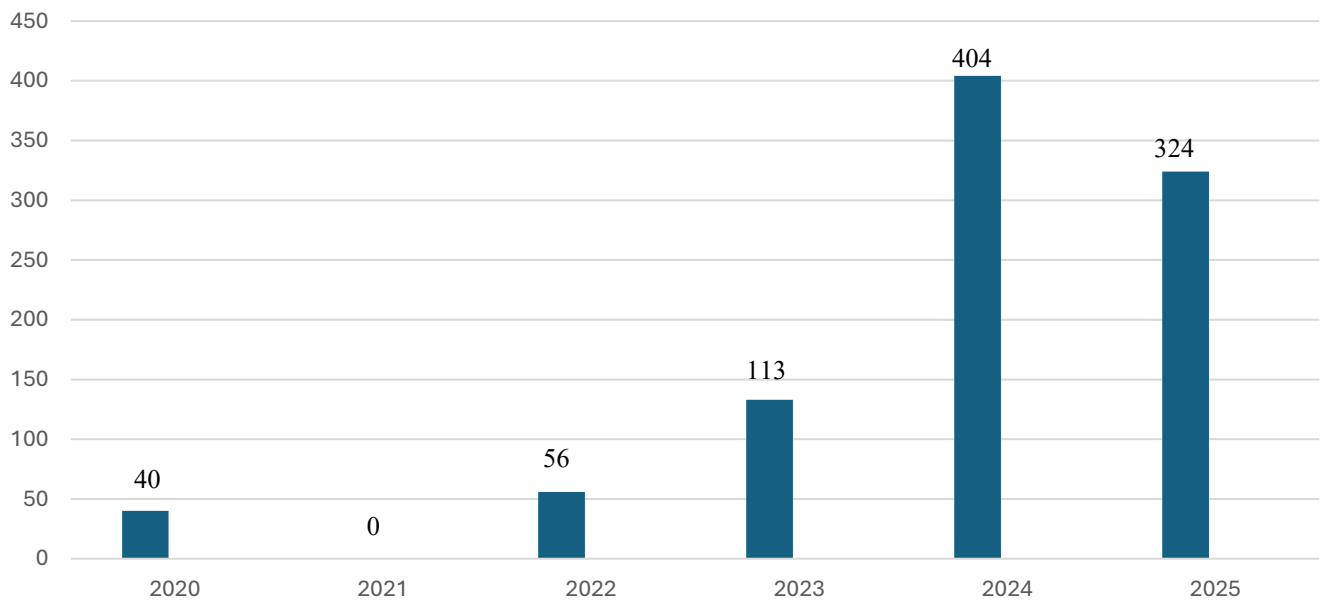

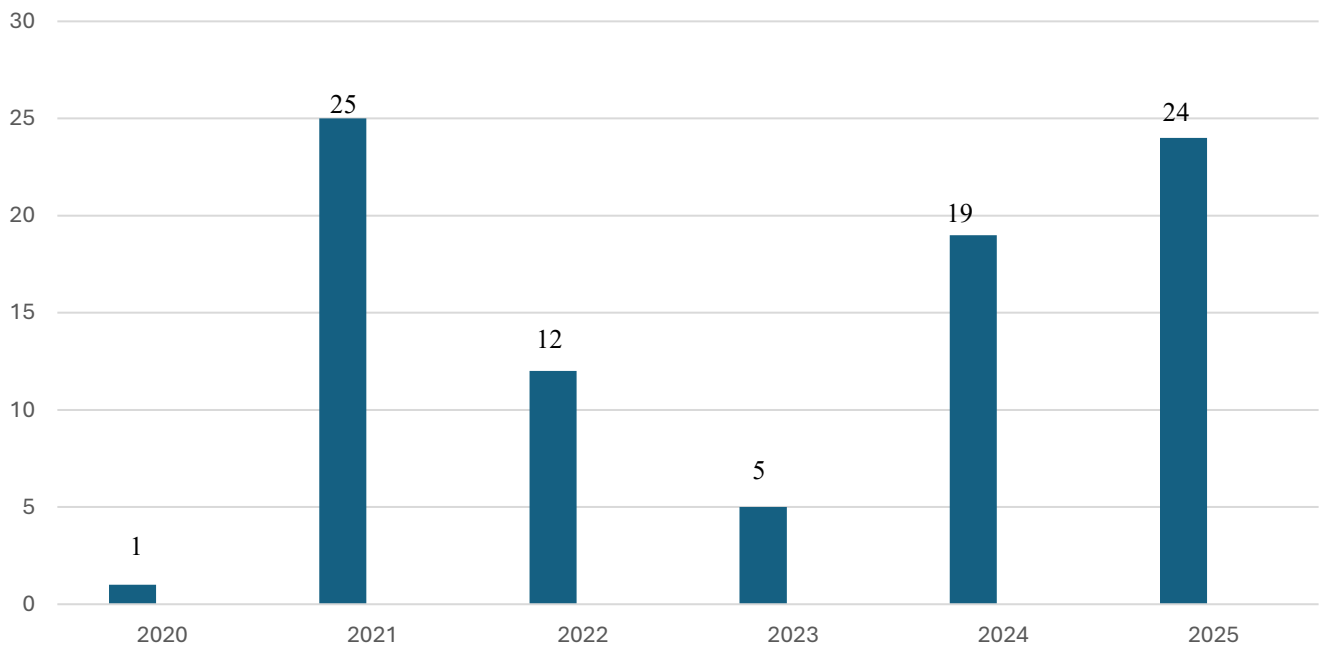
2020-2025 Number of Offline Training Courses for Technical Education and Training Division



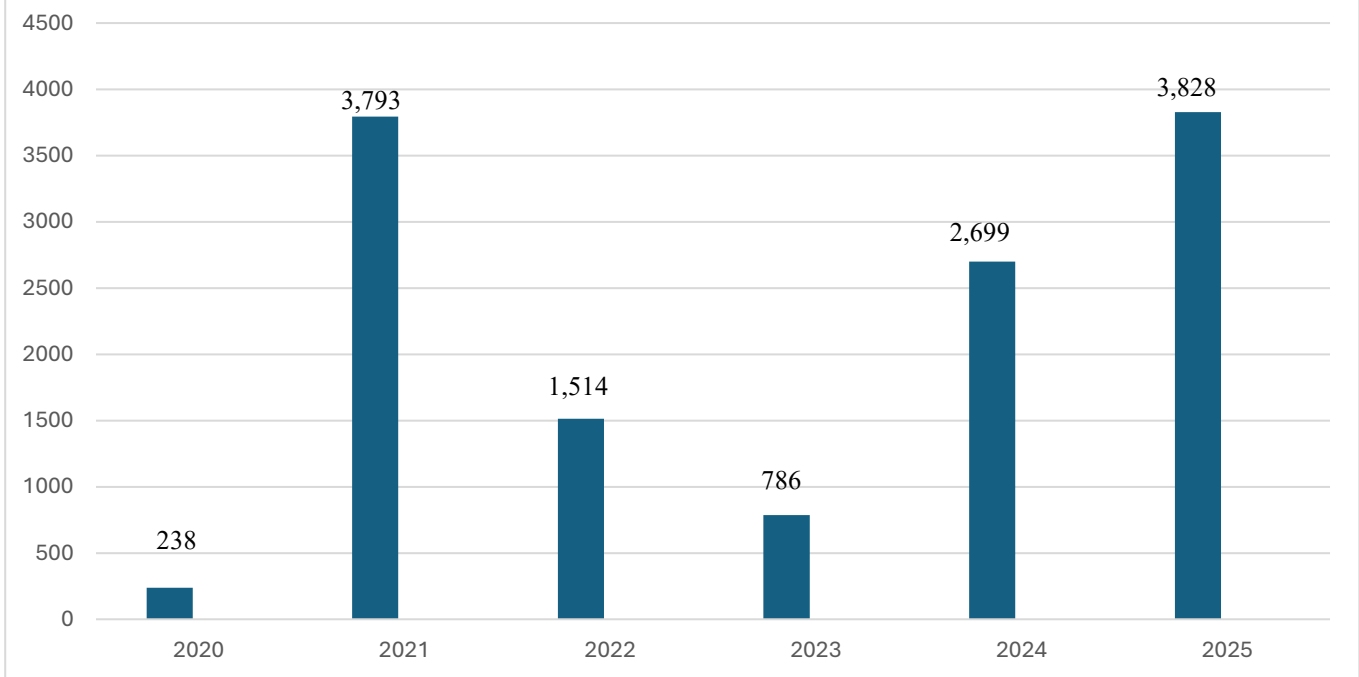
2020-2025 Number of Offline Participants for Technical Education and Training Division



2020-2025 Number of Online Training Courses for Technical Education and Training Division

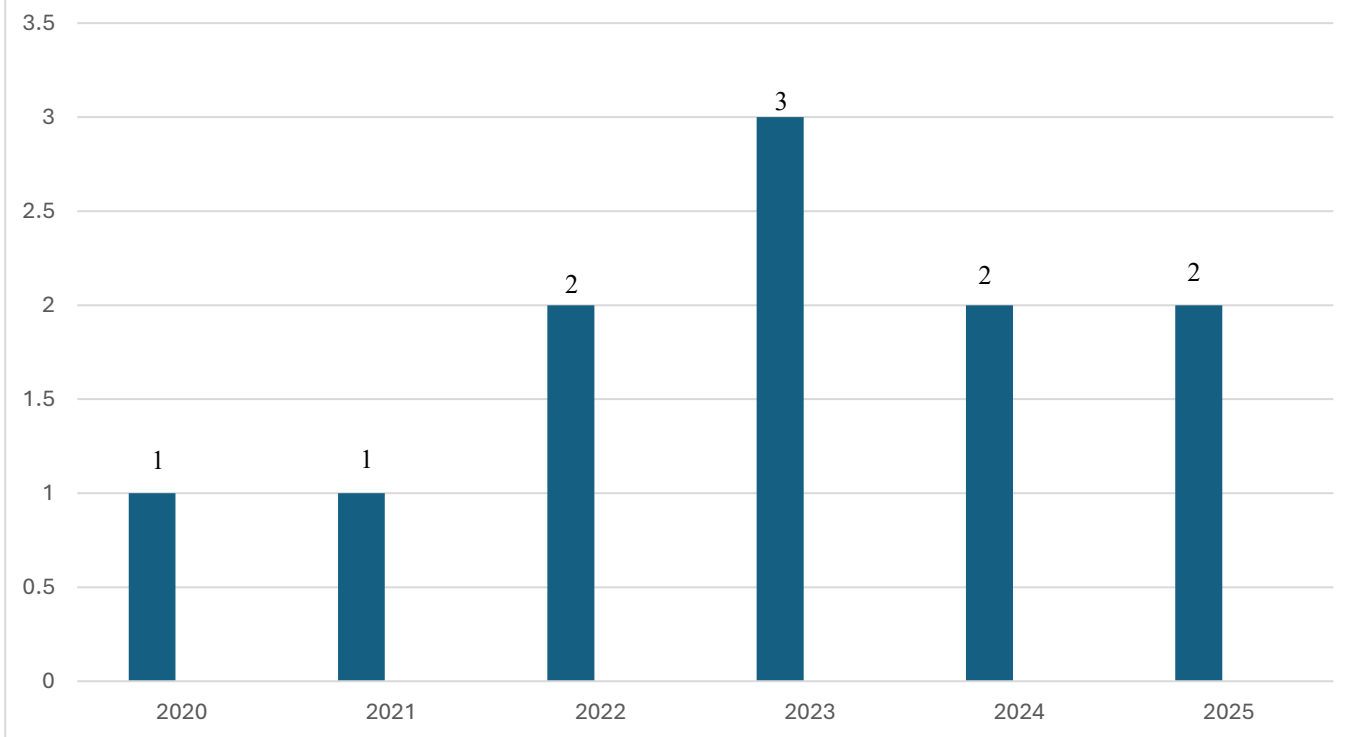


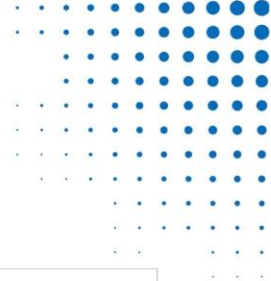
2020-2025 Number of Participants Joining Online Training Courses for Technical Education and Training Division



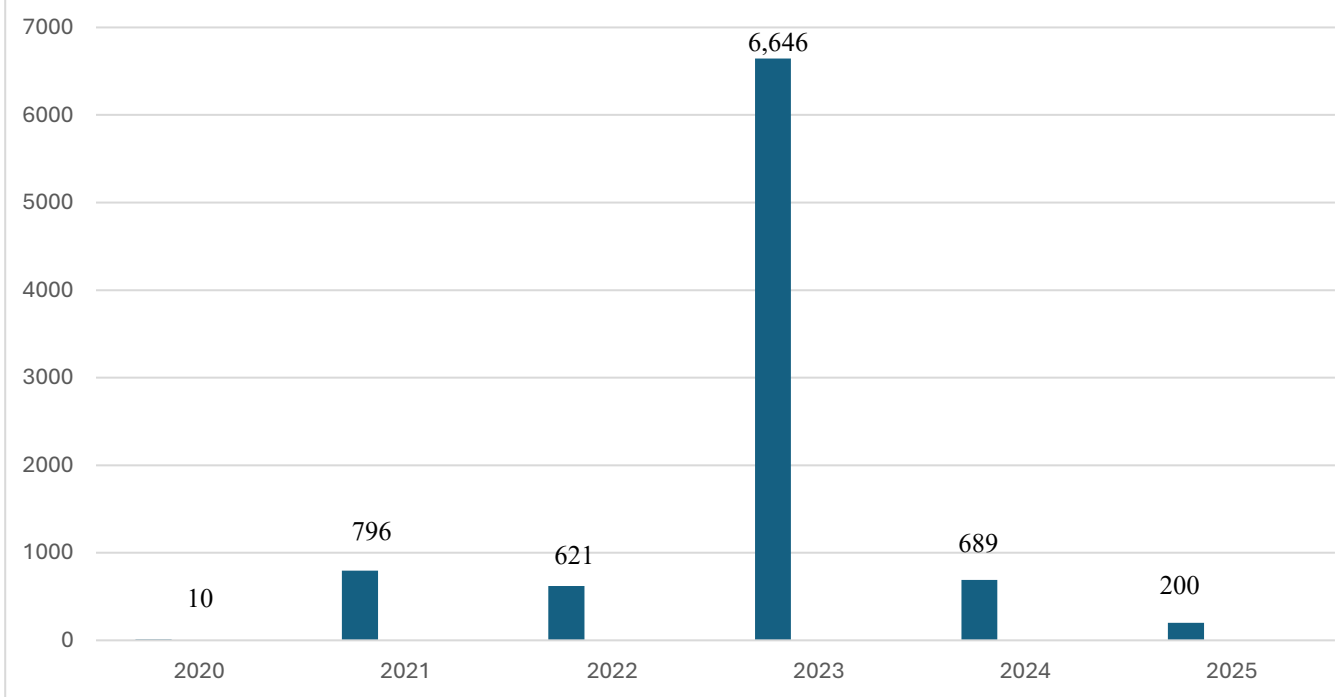

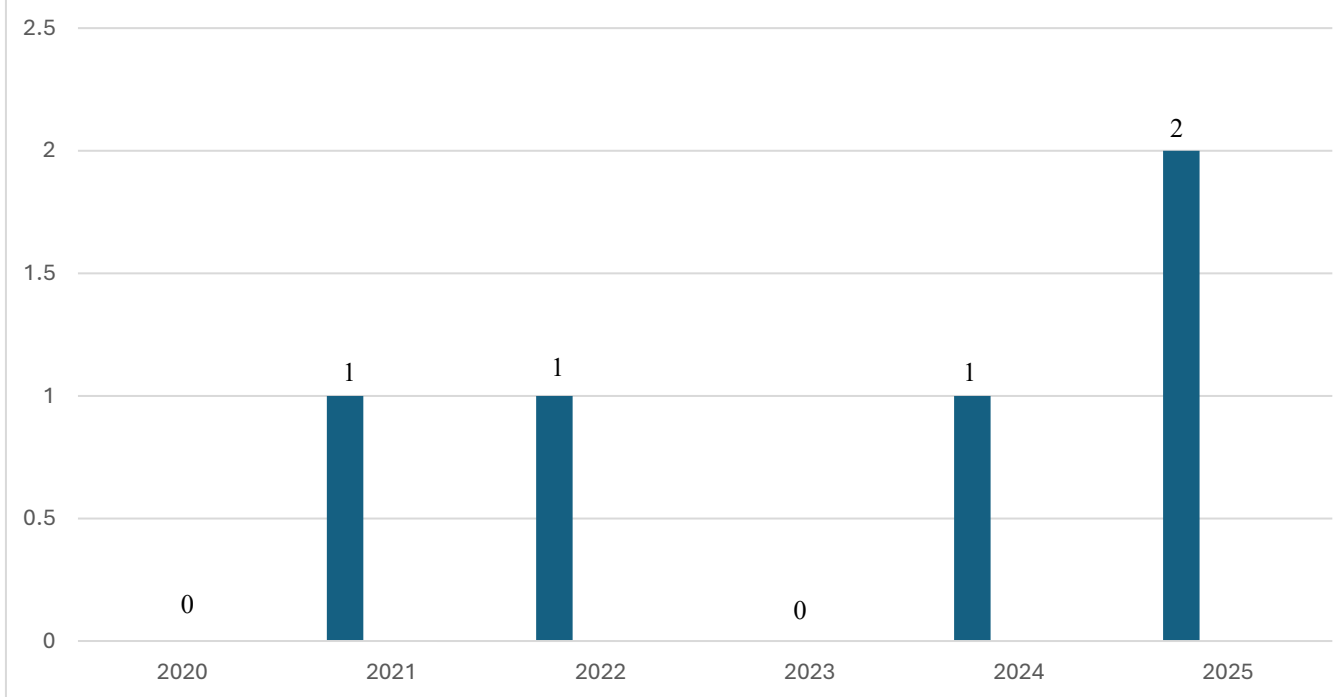




2020-2025 Number of Research Participants
